In June of 2007, the FMC membership approved a \$2.2 million building project consisting of a chapel/conference center and an office wing giving us much needed spaces for small group meetings as well as weddings, funerals and large group sessions. Since then, we have prayed and given, often sacrificially, toward the goal of building this expansion without debt. Currently we have over \$1.7 million in hand.

After much prayer and discussion, our elder team has determined that God is giving us the "go ahead" to begin construction on our building expansion! This morning we will be breaking ground during our worship gatherings and dedicating this process to God's glory.
